Beth Gaines' Legislative Solutions

- Bi-partisan legislation (AB 738) streamlining the law, so we can improve traffic flow.
- Support continued efforts to finish the Southeast Connector expressway, a 34-mile beltway connecting El Dorado Hills to Elk Grove, which will reduce the number of cars on Highway 50
- Dump Hi Speed Rail. Let's immediately freeze any further spending on the project, and shift those billions of dollars to our local roads.
- 4. State transportation dollars should be dedicated to transportation projects (SCA 1X 1). This will amend our state Constitution to guarantee the billions we pay annually in taxes by drivers are only used for transportation purposes, not for other government spending.
- Increase local control (SB 1X 10) by giving local agencies the flexibility they need to streamline the approval process to make sure that vital road projects are finished as fast as possible.
