Dear Chairman Holmes,

As you recall, at our Board meeting on April 10, 2018, I requested that the Board hear an item relative to the recently enacted California Senate Bill 54, commonly referred to as the "Sanctuary State" law. As yet, that item has not appeared on our agenda, even though sufficient time to prepare the item has passed since I requested the item.

You are no doubt aware that Section 7.2 of the Placer County Board of Supervisors Procedures, approved by our Board on June 18, 2013, states, "Any member may put an item on agenda without approval of the Chairman, but otherwise consistent with this rule."

I am formally requesting that an item be placed on the July 10, 2018, agenda relative to SB 54, specifically, "Should the Placer County Board of Supervisors: recognize the primacy of the federal government and the United States Constitution on matters regarding immigration and naturalization; advise all Placer County departments and agencies that they, too, will recognize the primacy of the federal government and the United States Constitution on matters regarding immigration and naturalization; file an amicus brief in support of the federal lawsuit against the Sanctuary State law?"

I look forward to our Board finally being able to discuss this matter of significance to the citizens of Placer County.
